CARDS FOR KIDS ACT

Students (ages 3-18) who live outside the library district *AND* whose household income makes them eligible to receive free or reduced-price lunches under the National School Lunch Program are eligible to receive a library card at no-cost. Qualifying students must present documentation from the school district to the Library as proof of eligibility before being issued a card.
